Chief cells

These lie proximally in the gastric crypts and produce pepsinogen. Two forms of pepsinogen are described: pepsinogen I and pepsinogen II. The ratio between pepsinogens I and II in the serum decreases with gastric atrophy. Pepsinogen is activated in the stomach to produce the digestive protease pepsin.
