

# Helicobacter pylori gastritis

## Helicobacter pylori gastritis

H. pylori gastritis, previously described as type B gastritis, affects the antrum and predisposes to peptic ulcer disease. Helicobacter-associated pangastritis is common, but gastritis affecting the corpus alone is not. Chronic pangastritis with atrophy is associated with intestinal metaplasia and has significant malignant potential when associated with dysplasia. Endoscopic screening may be appropriate.
