643 Mental and behavioural disorders associated with pregnancy, childbirth or the puerperium  
Boundary with normality (threshold) • Psychotic-like symptoms or unusual subjective experiences may occur in the general population, but these are usually fleeting in nature and do not interfere with functioning, and the person is typically aware that they are illusions. Such phenomena should not be diagnosed as mental and behavioural disorders associated with pregnancy, childbirth or the puerperium. Boundaries with other disorders and conditions (differential diagnosis) • This diagnosis may be assigned even if the syndrome represents a recurrence or exacerbation of a pre-existing disorder (e.g. a mood disorder, schizophrenia or another primary psychotic disorder).
